

1. Cut around the black line to make the bag's front and back panels 'Cutting Pattern'

**Tip: You can improve the bag by using this pattern to cut out both leather and lining (Dimensions: 19cm x 21cm)**

2. Cut around the black line to make the bag's back panel  
'Cutting Pattern'

### 3. Cut around the black line to make the bag flap 'Cutting Pattern'

● Cutting line    ● Hand stitching line example



You may want to use this pattern to cut out two leather flaps.  
You can sew the two flaps together so that your final bag flap is strengthened
